Description of works:

Est 1946

Works at the University of Exeter involved the refurbishment and redevelopment of a number of laboratories across the Streatham Campus, working in partnership with Willmott Dixon Construction as their Partner Builder. The works were split into three work-stream phases:

Phase 1 - A refurbishment of the laboratories in Hatherley Laboratory B12a and rooms BCO.1,2&5 in the Henry Welcome Building for Bio-catalysis

Phase 2 - The remodelling of the Geoffrey Pope level 03 laboratories and offices, and the level 04 breakout area.

Phase 3 & 4 - Refurbishment and conversion/extension of the existing Living Systems Institute (LSI) external delivery bay into a containment suite and internal alterations in the basement level 01.
