Description of Work:

The new building was formed incorporating a structural steel frame, masonry inner skins with K-Rend and faced brickwork externals including boarding finishes, aluminium windows and doors, membrane roof and underfloor heating.

The value of this project was just under £1m and was completed in August 2016 in readiness for the new school year.

Where possible the works were planned to make use of the school holiday periods so as not to disrupt the school terms any more than necessary including installation of four temporary classrooms, new service connections drainage diversions and temporary access roads.
