Description of works:

The school's website describes music at Blundell's as a thriving centre of excellence through ambitious concert programming, passionate and expert teaching and dynamic and forward-thinking opportunities.

Blundell's pupils perform in the world's best venues and work with the country's finest musicians. Many of Blundell's pupils go on to read Music at top universities and conservatoires. The music building consists of the original building attached to the main Hall of the Big School dating from the late 19 th/early 20th century and consisting of music practice rooms. A 2007 extension provided a formal entrance foyer, music classrooms and a recording suite. The building's fabric consists of brick/render/stone external walls and aluminium windows under a slate pitched roof.


Works were carried out in a phased manner, whilst the school remained in live occupation. The initial procurement of these works was through a two stage open book tender process.
